Sub:— Indexing of names of persons in the preamble of partition deeds who do not execute it either due to absence or unwillingness — Orders communicating of: —

A doubt has been raised as to whether the persons appear in the preamble of the partition deed who have executed the deed due to their absence, unwillingness or inability to join the execution of the deed have to be indexed as claimants under section 55(2) of the Indian Registration Act. Though they have not executed the deed their rights are affected and hence they are indexed as claimants. The Inspector General of Registration pleased to order that "in a partition deed all those who sign and admit execution are to be indexed as both executants and claimants and the rest who do not sign or do not admit execution have to be indexed as claimants only.
